

25. Supply List for Abby's Delight class

Size of Quilt: Lap – 58"x74"

The instructor will give the pattern free when the class begins. **You do not have to buy the pattern.** You may want to refer to the picture of Abby's Delight quilt in the class descriptions when selecting your fabrics.

Fabric Requirements:

*Assorted White tone on tone – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ Yds

*Assorted Prints – 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ Yds

**Foundation – 2 Yds

Triangle Units (aqua in picture) – $\frac{3}{4}$ Yds

First & Third Border – 1 Yd

Binding/Optional Flange: 5/8 yds each

Backing: 5 yds

*yardage is approximate. Use your stash, the more variety, the better.

**I use a foundation method for my string blocks (white blocks in the quilt). This foundation helps to maintain their shape and doesn't require removal of paper.

Cutting Instructions:

1. Assorted White tone on tone: Cut a variety of widths of strips, ranging from 1" to 2". There will be a variety of lengths. Use your stash.
2. Assorted Prints: 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares or use 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for strip piecing into sets of 2's.
3. Triangle Units (aqua in quilt): Cut (6) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof – subcut into (96) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Rectangles.
4. Foundation fabric for String piecing: I used Sheer Delight, but you can use any lightweight interfacing (not fusible), or muslin. This will not be removed from block. If you prefer to remove paper, you can use paper.
Cut (24) 11" x 10" rectangles

This is a technique class. You will learn how we make the blocks without cutting individual triangles. We will make 10 blocks in class.
